Gaetan J. Alfano Elected to the Philadelphia Bar  
Association's Board of Governors

Philadelphia. Gaetan J. Alfano, a founding shareholder of the Philadelphia law firm Miller, Alfano & Raspanti, was elected to one of five seats on the Philadelphia Bar Association's Board of Governors on Tuesday, December 5, 2006. The Board of Governors is a leadership committee for the Philadelphia Bar Association, and Mr. Alfano's term will last for three years.

Mr. Alfano's running was endorsed by the Philadelphia Bar Association's Nominating Committee, the Philadelphia Association of Defense Counsel Executive Committee, the Public Interest Law Section, the Justinian Society, the Brehon Law Society, the Philadelphia Trial Lawyers Association, and the Louis D. Brandeis Law Society, among others. For the election, lawyers across Philadelphia either mailed in their votes by ballot or went to the polls on December 5 to vote in person. Mr. Alfano received the third highest number of votes among the eight candidates.

Mr. Alfano is recognized as a top commercial litigator by his peers, and he has extensive experience in commercial disputes, employment disputes, insurance insolvency, and white collar criminal defense. Miller, Alfano & Raspanti was formally certified as a Minority-Owned Business Enterprise ("MBE") by both the National Minority Supplier Development Council ("NMSDC") and the Department of General Services of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania in 2006. America's oldest law journal has referred to it as one of Philadelphia's "premier litigation boutiques."

Mr. Alfano received his B.A. from Villanova University magna cum laude and received his J.D. from Villanova University School of Law.
