- Arrow Electronics to Become Leading Distributor of IBM and HP Enterprise Product -

NEW YORK, April 4, 2007 – In a move to capitalize on the rapid growth of the value-added storage and software business, Arrow Electronics, Inc. has completed its \$485 million acquisition of the KeyLink Systems Group distribution group of Agilysys, Inc. and Agilysys Canada Inc. Based in Cleveland, Ohio, KeyLink is a leading value-added distributor of enterprise servers, storage and software in the United States and Canada. The acquisition of KeyLink, which will be integrated into Arrow’s Enterprise Computing Solutions (“ECS”) group, increases Arrow’s market share in the rapidly growing segment of value-added storage and software. Arrow also becomes the largest distributor of IBM and HP Enterprise Products
