Gaetan J. Alfano Elected as Secretary/Treasurer of the
Delaware River Joint Toll Bridge Commission

Philadelphia. Gaetan J. Alfano, a founding shareholder of the Philadelphia law firm Miller, Alfano & Raspanti, was elected as the Secretary/Treasurer of the Delaware River Joint Toll Bridge Commission on Monday, December 18, 2006. In August 2005, Pennsylvania Governor Edward G. Rendell appointed Mr. Alfano to the ten-member Commission.

The Delaware River Joint Toll Bridge Commission is composed of five members from Pennsylvania and five members from New Jersey. It operates seven toll and thirteen toll-supported bridges from the Philadelphia-Bucks county line to the New York state border. In addition, the Commission evaluates any need for additional crossings. As the Secretary Treasurer of the Commission, Mr. Alfano will be working with a capital budget of \$140 million and an operating budget of \$44 million.

Mr. Alfano is recognized as a top commercial litigator by his peers, and he has extensive experience in commercial disputes, employment disputes, insurance insolvency, and white collar criminal defense. Miller, Alfano & Raspanti was formally certified as a Minority-Owned Business Enterprise ("MBE") by both the National Minority Supplier Development Council ("NMSDC") and the Department of General Services of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania in 2006.
