

Franklin & Marshall Elects Raymond Sanseverino as Trustee

Sanseverino, a 1968 graduate in English, is a partner at the national law firm Loeb & Loeb LLP in New York City. He specializes in commercial real estate law and is chair of the law firm's Real Estate Department and its Commercial Real Estate Leasing Group. He represents landlords and tenants in leasing and brokerage transactions and purchasers and sellers in sales transactions. He received his law degree cum laude from Fordham University in 1972.

As a member of the Board of Trustees, Sanseverino will provide leadership to the College and oversee all aspects of the College's activities.
