

## **Supreme Court Rules in MedImmune Biotech Patent Case; Expert Lawyer Can Comment**

Jan. 9, 2007—The US Supreme Court today ruled for MedImmune in its case against Genentech, in a key biotech patent case.

The Supreme Court reversed the US Court of Appeals for the Federal Circuit and sent the case back to the lower courts. The decision affects broad issues in patent licensing and allows MedImmune to challenge the validity and scope of the specific biotech patent at hand.
