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Marc S. Raspanti to Speak at the Health Care Compliance
Association's 11th Annual Compliance Institute

Philadelphia. Marc S. Raspanti, a founding partner of the Philadelphia law firm Miller, Alfano & Raspanti, will speak at the Health Care Compliance Association's 11th Annual Compliance Institute on April 24, 2007, in Chicago.

The HCCA's 11th Annual Compliance Institute is the largest health care compliance conference in the world. It offers many of the health care industry's leaders as faculty, contributing their knowledge and expertise. They will discuss a wide range of timely issues, providing the latest regulatory and enforcement information. The Compliance Institute will be organized into special tracks to meet the varying needs of the health care compliance professionals who will be attending. Some tracks offered will be General Compliance/Hot Topics, Legal and Regulatory, Quality of Care, and Auditing and Monitoring.

Mr. Raspanti's presentation will be entitled, "Theories of Liability and Defenses Under the False Claims Act." Mr. Raspanti's co-presenters will be Michael Granston, Assistant Director of the U.S. Department of Justice's Fraud Section, Civil Division, and Jack Boese. The presentation will be a part of the Institute's Legal and Regulatory Track.

Mr. Raspanti focuses his areas of practice to white collar criminal defense, criminal and civil health care fraud defense, federal and state *qui tam* litigation, professional licensing litigation and complex commercial disputes. He was named one of the best white collar criminal defense lawyers by *Philadelphia Magazine*, and was selected as one of *Pennsylvania's Super Lawyers* from 2004-2007, an honor reserved for only 5% of the Pennsylvania Bar. The selection process for *Super Lawyers* involves nomination by way of a statewide survey of attorneys

followed by rigorous evaluations by the *Super Lawyers* research department, and then a second evaluation completed by peer attorneys. At the end of the process, the attorneys with the highest scores are selected as *Super Lawyers*.

Mr. Raspanti was also selected for the 2007 edition of *Best Lawyers in America* for the category of health care law litigation. Each lawyer included in the volume was selected based on an extensive peer-review survey that has been developed over twenty years. *The Best Lawyers in America* is an advertisement-free book published each year with the purpose of honoring those selected for inclusion. The peer-review survey conducted by *Best Lawyers in America* consists of a compilation of over a million attorney evaluations which are completed confidentially by their peers across the United States. The 2007 edition of *The Best Lawyers in America* will be published later this fall.

Mr. Raspanti has served as lead trial counsel in a number of high-profile white collar cases, some of which were among the longest and most complex white collar criminal trials ever tried in the Eastern District of Pennsylvania. Mr. Raspanti is an active member of the American Health Lawyers Association, the National Association of Criminal Defense Lawyers, and the Health Care Compliance Association. Mr. Raspanti received his B.A. from Villanova University and his J.D. from Temple University School of Law.

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
