

**Marc S. Raspanti Speaks in the National Constitution
Center's Audio Conference**

PHILADELPHIA, PA, April 23, 2008- Marc S. Raspanti, a name partner in the law firm of Pietragallo Gordon Alfano Bosick & Raspanti, LLP, presented via telephone in the National Constitution Center's 60 minute Audio Conference. Numerous attendees from 28 states participated in this audio program.

The presentation was entitled, "**How to Conduct an Internal Investigation- and Not Screw it Up**". It provided the latest information from a seasoned practitioner on how to conduct investigations designed to minimize corporate liability and regulatory intervention.

Mr. Raspanti highlighted key issues such as: when should you conduct an internal investigation; when, how and by whom internal investigations should be handled; the most common mistakes and how to avoid them; and the issues involving Privilege, Waiver and Data Preservation.

Mr. Raspanti serves as Chair of the firm's white collar criminal defense practice. He focuses his practice on white collar criminal defense, criminal and civil health care fraud defense, internal corporate investigations, compliance, federal and state *qui tam* litigation, professional licensing litigation and complex civil litigation.
